| 2. OPEN HACKAMORE | JACKPOT | HERD | \$80 |
| Open to horses not over 5 yrs old that have never been shown in a bridle down the fence. | | | |
| 3. NON PRO SNAFFLE BIT/HACKAMORE | JACKPOT | HERD | \$80 |
| See rules governing OPEN SNAFFLE BIT AND OPEN HACKAMORE for age restrictions | | | |
| 4. NON PRO BRIDLE | JACKPOT | HERD | \$80 |
| A NON PRO is defined as anyone who is not currently receiving remuneration directly or indirectly for training, showing, giving lessons, clinics or assisting in the training of a horse for remuneration. Horses must be owned by exhibitor or exhibitor's family (spouse, child, stepchild, parent, grandparent, grandchild, step-parent, sibling, half-sibling, spouse's parent, spouse's step-parent, sibling's spouse, half sibling's spouse, step-sibling's spouse), legal ward or legal guardian. | | | |
| 5. OPEN BRIDLE HORSE | JACKPOT | HERD | \$80 |
| Open bridle horses only. | | | |
| 6. GREEN BRIDLE/TWO REIN | JACKPOT | HERD | \$80 |
| If shown in two rein, horses not to be over 7 and never shown "straight up" in the bridle.
Green Bridle horses not to have been shown in the Bridle prior to 1-1 of the current year. | | | |
| 7. BUCKAROO NON PRO RIDERS ONLY | | HERD | \$80 |
| Horses 5 and under may be shown in snaffle bit or hackamore at rider's discretion. Rider may not have gone down the fence 3 times in any judged reined cow horse event held at any time, at any place. | | | |
| 8. JR. STOCKHORSE | | HERD | \$40 |
| Horses 5 and under may be shown in snaffle bit or hackamore at rider's discretion.
Horses of any age may be shown in the two rein for 1 year only or in the bridle. | | | |

Nevada Reined Cow & Cutting Horse Association rules to apply to all classes: chaps, leather curb straps, half breed or spade bits to be used. Owners and riders must be current NRC&CHA members.
